

The 31st ACM Symposium on Applied Computing Tutorial Submission Guidelines

Tutorials must address timely state-of-the-art topics related to SAC Tracks and be of interest to the Applied Computing community and SAC attendees.

The duration of a tutorial can be full-day (6 hours) or half-day (3 hours).

A tutorial proposal should not exceed 6 pages and should contain the following information:

- Title of the tutorial
- Duration (full-day or half-day)
- 300 Words abstract (1-2 paragraphs suitable for inclusion on the website and in conference registration materials)
- Description of the tutorial (summary and outline)
- Specific goals and objectives
- Expected background of the audience
- Relevant references that would support proposal evaluation
- Time plan for tutorial materials preparation (including when the materials can be made online for participants to access)
- Information on presenters (name, affiliation, e-mail address, short bio, experience in teaching and in tutorial presentation)

We recall that SAC tutorials are open to all attendees and that each accepted tutorial receives one free full registration. No other compensation is offered. If the tutorial has more than one presenter, it is up to the presenters to decide who uses the free registration.
