Most of the attractions in Lucca today show its ancient history, from the trace of the Roman amphitheatre , still visible in the shape of the Piazza dell'Anfiteatro, to the many towers and villas from the 12th to the 16th centuries.</p>

You will be fascinated by incredible landscapes, almost paintings! VOLTERRA, an important centre of Etruscan, Roman, Medieval and Renaissance art, dominates the Cecina Valley, 550 metres above sea level, affording a spectacular view as far as the sea.. SAN GIMIGNANO, declared by UNESCO "World Heritage Site", is a typical Tuscan walled town characterised by fine medieval towers.</p>
